Saying a word back to others is a functional skill for Sofia so she can engage with others about her wants and needs. Her family identified this is as a priority skill to understand her preferences, wants, and needs.

This is a measurable skill. Sofia's family and provider can hear her say a word.

How will we know it's working?

Sofia's mom shared that it usually helps to wait a few seconds for Sofia to say a word back to someone before giving an extra cue. Wait time and extra cues are strategies that can be used to support Sofia's priority skill of saying a word back when others talk to her. While at the church playgroup, Grandma can provide opportunities for Sofia to practice saying a word back when her friends talk to her. Sue can provide opportunities for Sofia to practice saying a word back during mealtimes and playtimes.

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
